The Dodgers are excited to announce the signings of Scott Kelly, Kevin Brown and Stevie Lewis. Scott Kelly, from Belleville Ontario, is a graduate of the Oshawa Junior Legionaires. He was selected by the San Diego Padres in the 25th Round of the 2001 amateur entry draft and then selected by the New York Yankees in the 28th Round of the 2003 amateur entry draft. He is currently attending Missouri Valley College.

Catcher Kevin Brown returns to the Dodgers after playing twelve games in the 2005 season. Kevin attended William Woods University in 2006/07 where he hit .284 with 24 RBI in 43 games.
