Dodgers Off to Best Start in Franchise History

The Oshawa Dodgers have gotten off to the best start in team history having won seven of ten games in the first month of the season. The Dodgers feats in May included sweeping doubleheaders with Stratford and London and defeating the Brantford Red Sox at Kinsmen Stadium for the first time since the 2003 playoffs. RHP Adam Garner has been one of the top performers earning victories in each of his three outings including complete games in both starts. He has a league leading 0.96 ERA in 18.2 innings pitched. RHP Cam Gray and 15-year-old LHP Evan Grills have also been solid for the Dodgers, second and fourth in the IBL in ERA respectively.

Offensively, Stevie Lewis has picked up where he left off last season batting .360 with 9 hits and 6 RBI. Sean Cunningham has also wielded a hot bat to start the season leading all regulars with 10 hits and a .385 average.

Crohn's and Colitis Day

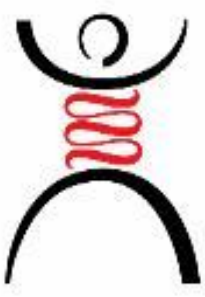
